# What is BadgerNet?


- Maternity electronic patient record (ERR).
- Used in the community and hospital. Also has an app (Maternity Notes) for patients to access parts of the record.
- Special forms for anaesthesia allow recording of our notes.
- Anaesthetists can:
  - Record pre-operative reviews.
  - Document procedure details for patients who have had an anaesthetic.
  - Record all epidural related care.
  - Generate a list of patients who require follow-up.
  - Enter follow-up information.
  - Enter any other clinical notes.
- Paper anaesthetic records are still used to record most things in theatre.

# How do we access BadgerNet?

- BadgerNet is installed on all PCs in AMH.
- All rooms in Labour Ward have PCs in them. There are also several Computers on Wheels (COWs) in AMH.
- There are many iPads with the BadgerNet app installed. The app has a different look to it and is covered in another presentation.
- To log in:
  - Look for the Badger icon on the desktop.
  - Double click on the icon to open Badger.



# Anaesthesia Note

- Every anaesthetic in every patient should have an Anaesthesia note created. One note for each spinal, epidural, epidural top-up in theatre, CSE and GA.
- Some patients will have multiple notes.
- Fill in as much information as possible.
- Epidural insertion, boluses and assessments should be recorded only in BadgerNet.
- Spinal insertion and assessment can be entirely recorded in BadgerNet. There is no need to duplicate this on the paper record; just write 'See BadgerNet'.
- Anaesthetic assessments still need to be recorded on paper.






