# Epidural Request

- When you attend to assess the patient and site the epidural, complete all documentation in BadgerNet.
- This includes:
  - Anaesthetic Pre-Op Review note (see separate guide).
  - Anaesthetic note for epidural insertion.
  - All epidural boluses.
  - All epidural assessments.
- Documentation should be done as soon as possible, while still in the room, using the PC there, or one of the many iPads.

- For consistency, the times in the Anaesthesia note are as below:
  - Time called – when we get the call requesting our input.
  - Time arrived – when we first arrive.
  - Time commenced – when we apply skin prep.
  - Time anaesthetic sited – when the epidural catheter is sited.
  - Time completed – when we finish securing the epidural catheter.
- If there are any delays, then document the reason in the Additional Epidural Notes field, or in a clinical note.




