

BadgerNet iPad App


- The iPad app uses the same forms as the PC version, but shows them in a slightly different way.
- Your existing BadgerNet username and password will work in the iPad app.
- When you log in to the app, you will be asked to choose a 6 digit PIN.
 - As long as you are logged in, you can use this PIN instead of your username and password.
 - If someone else has used the app after you, then you will need to create a new PIN the next time you log in.

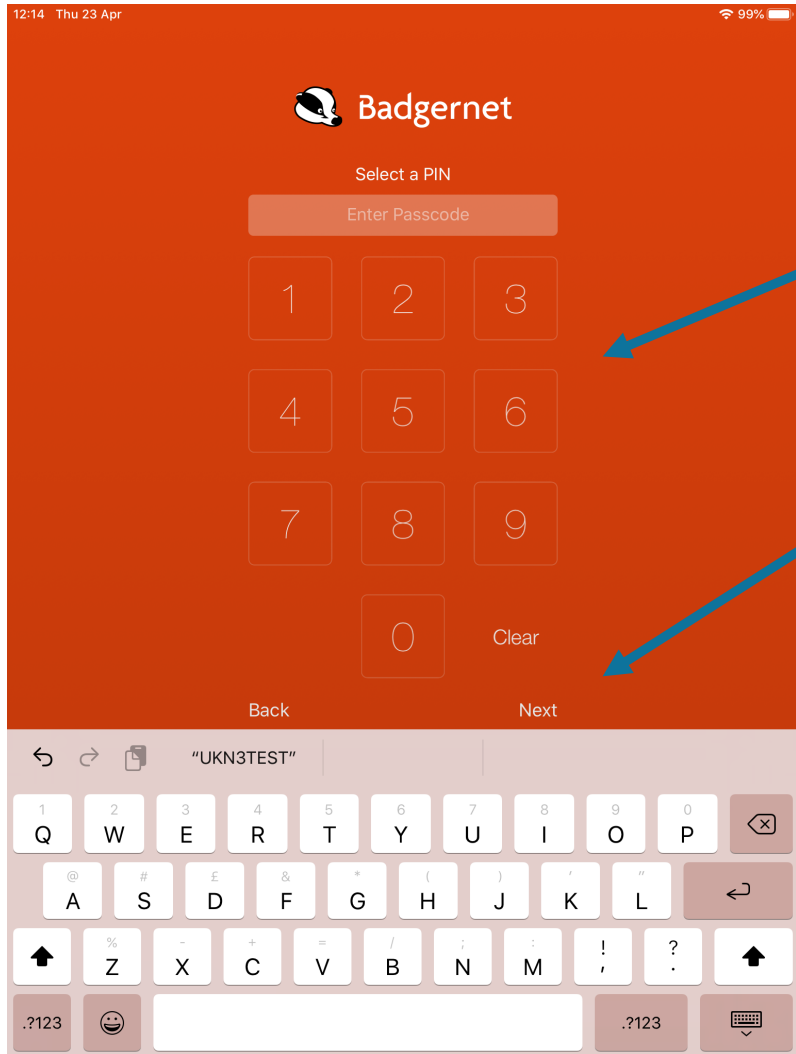

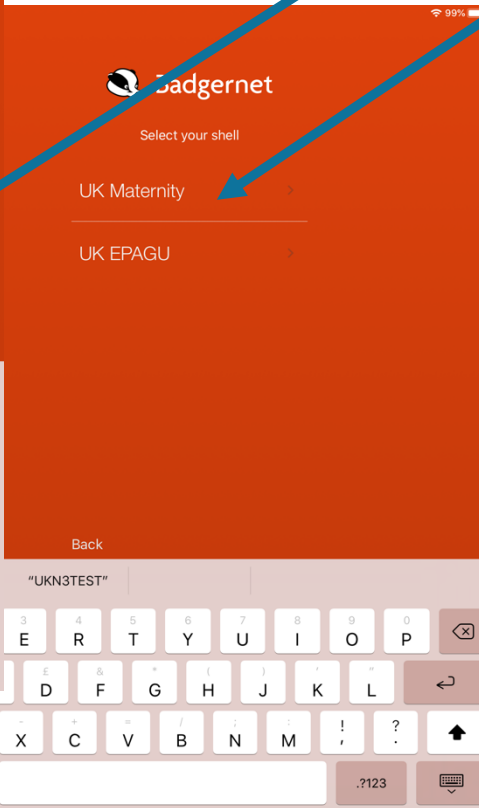

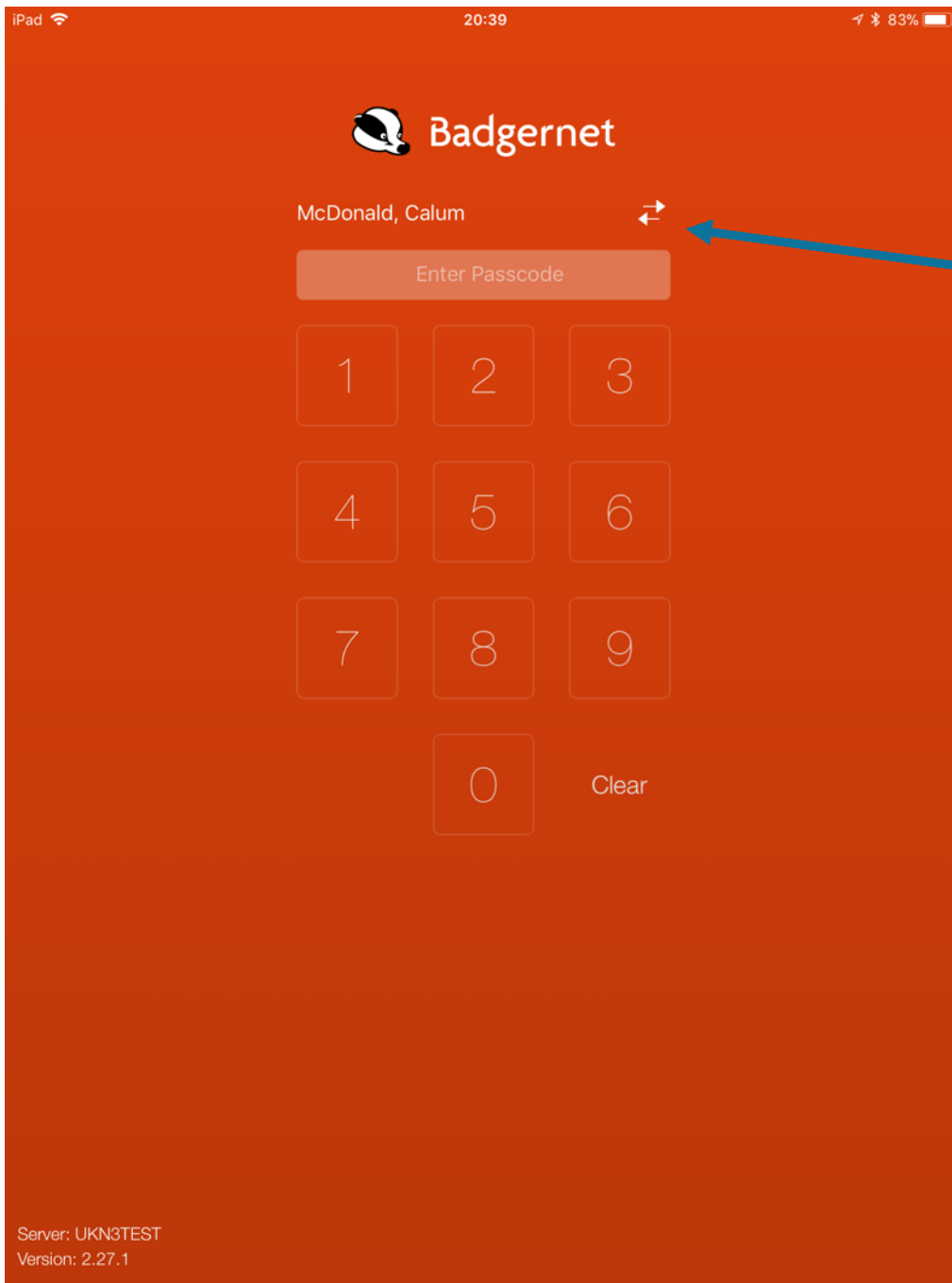
Logging In – Choose a PIN



- Choose a six digit PIN using the keypad.
- Tap Next and re-enter the PIN and tap Next again.
- Tap UK Maternity.
- Your PIN can be used to quickly log in to the app again, as long as you are still logged in. If someone else has logged in then you will need to start again as shown on the next page.
- Your PIN can be used to authorise some notes in BadgerNet.

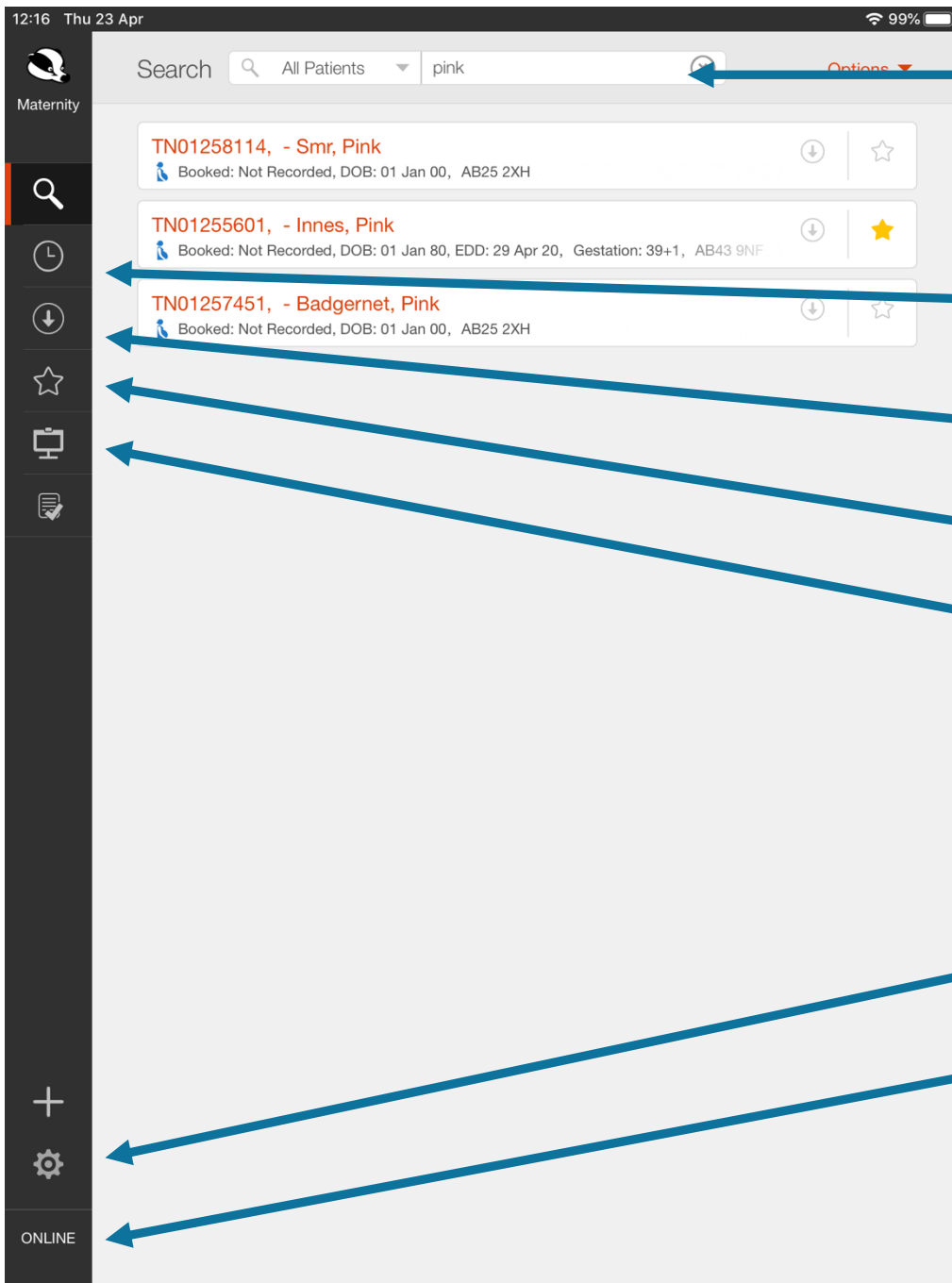


Logging In



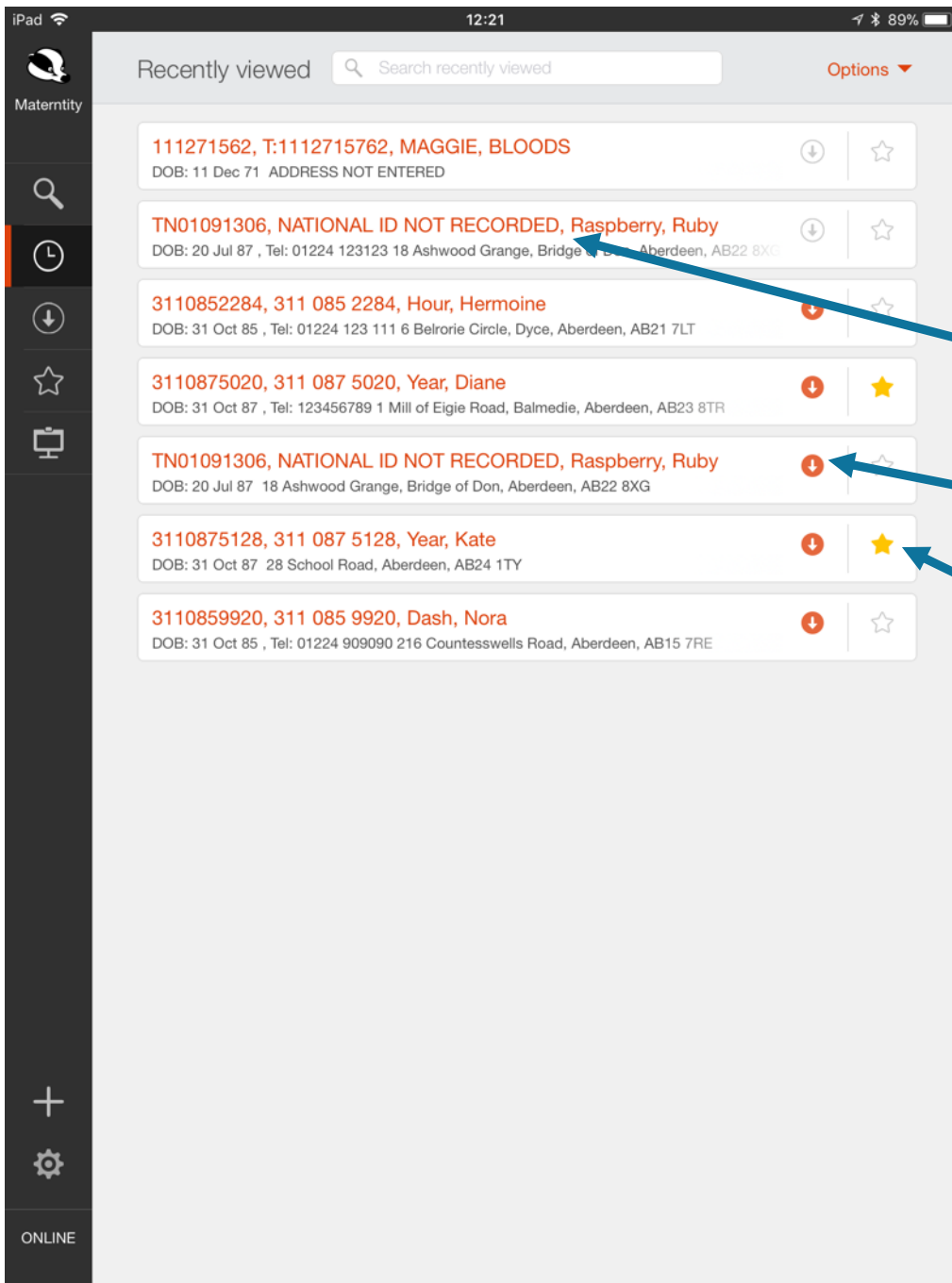
- If someone is already logged in you will see this screen. If it's you, enter your Passcode to open the app.
- If it's not you, tap on the two arrows pointing in the opposite direction to go back to the log in screen.

Main Screen





- Enter the CHI or name of the patient you are searching for. **If searching by name, confirm the DOB and CHI match your patient.** Tap on a patient to open their record.
- See patients you have recently viewed.
- See patients you have downloaded to the app for offline use.
- See patients marked as favourites.
- Whiteboards, or patient lists.
- **The app only remembers recent, downloaded and favourite patients as long as you are signed in.**
- Tap here for settings and to log out.
- This shows if your are online or offline.

Recent Patients List



- All viewed patients are in this list and the Downloaded and Favourites list as long as you are logged in to the iPad. If you use another iPad, or log out and back in, then these lists will be empty.
- Tap on the patient to go to their record.
- Tap here to download a patient to the iPad for offline use.
- Tap here to add a patient to your favourites list.

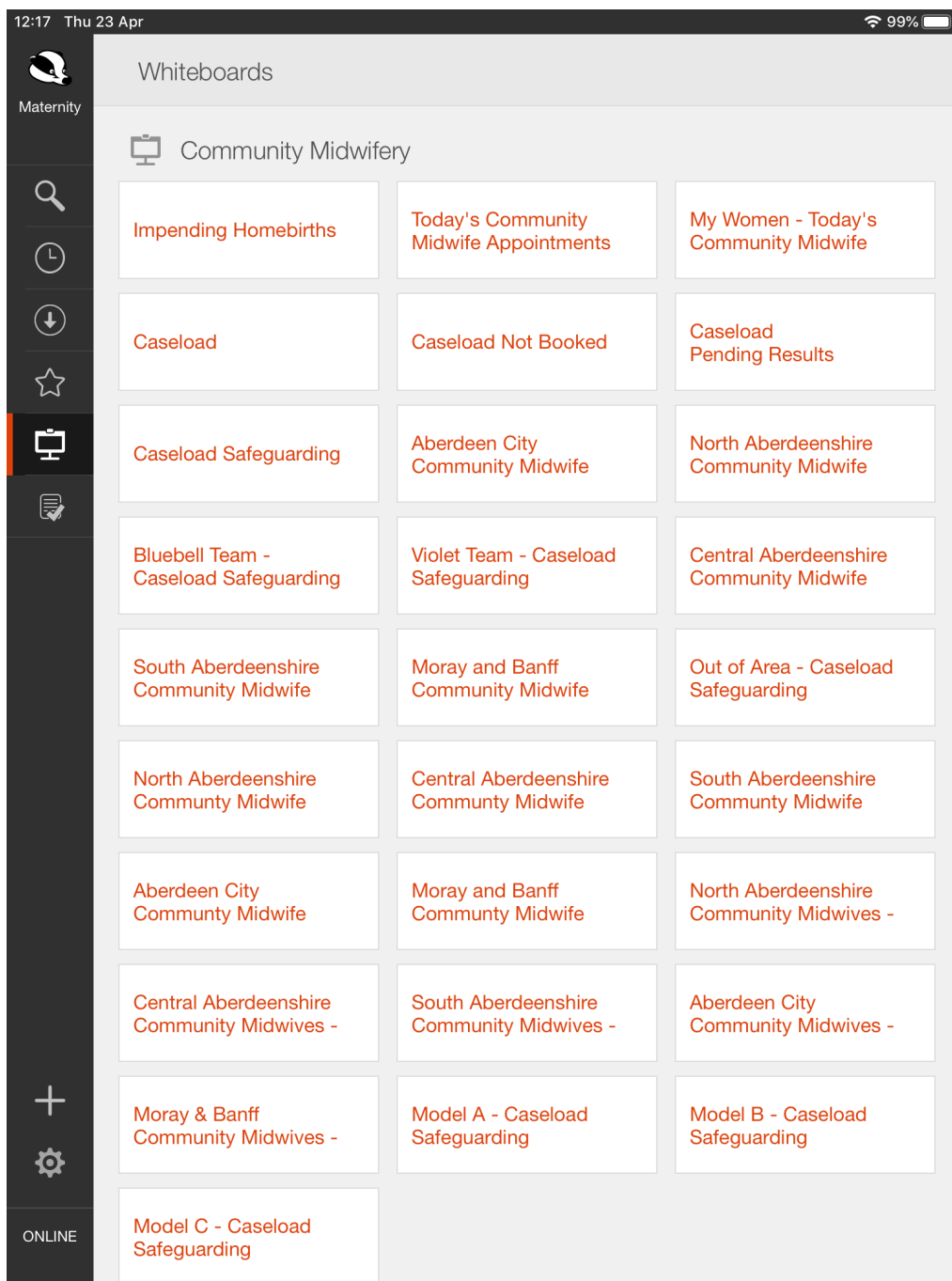

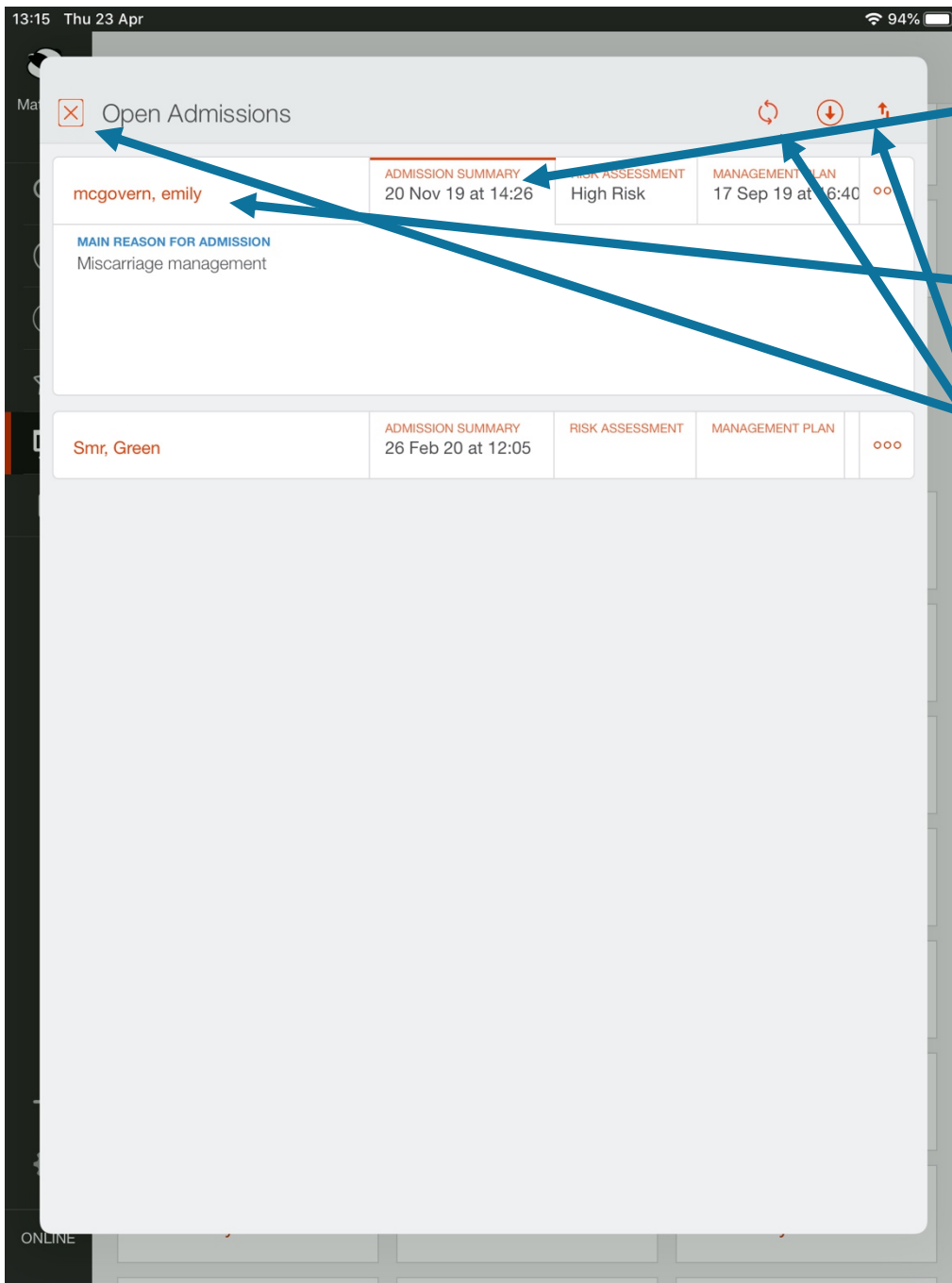

Whiteboards



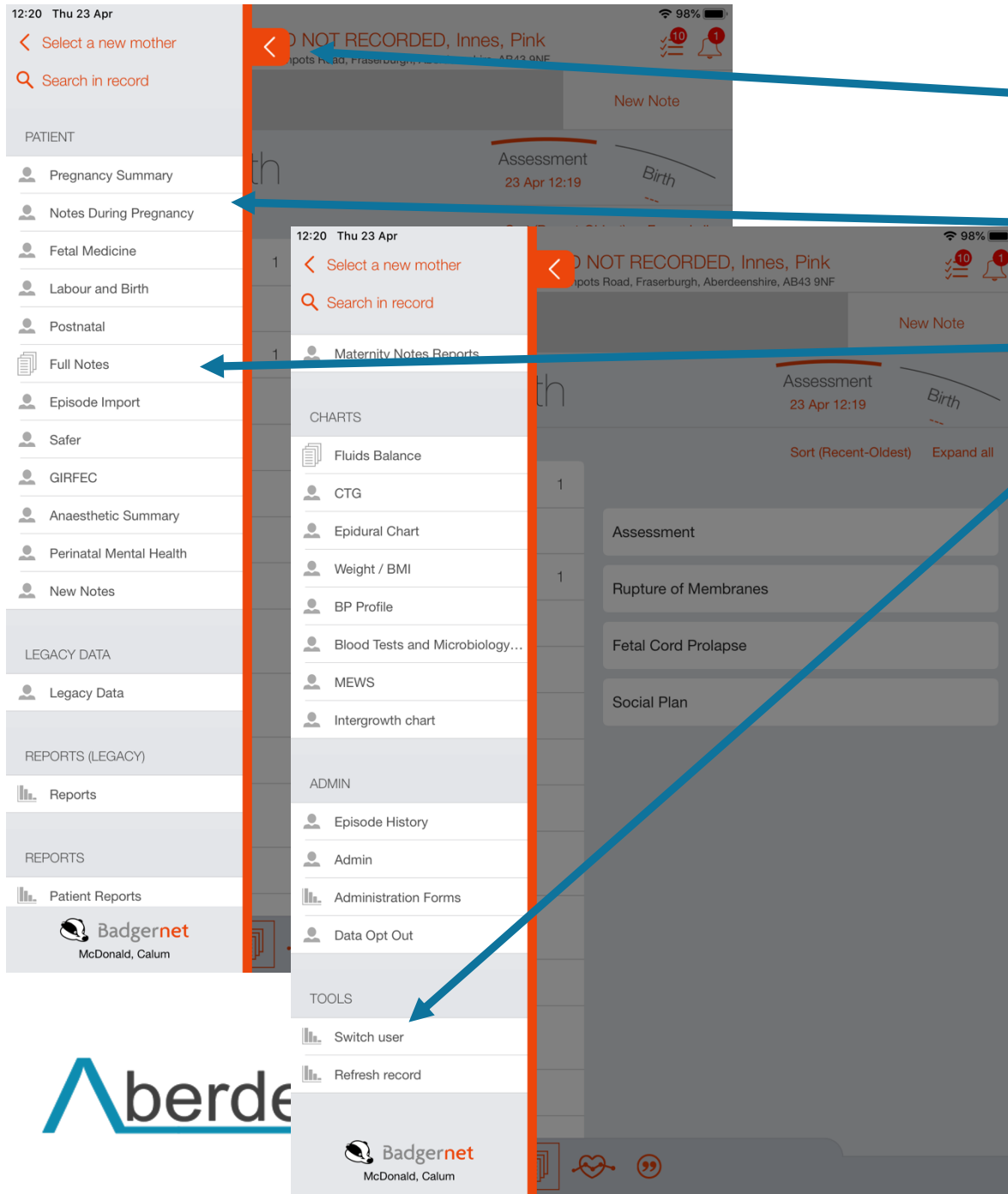
- Whiteboards is the iPad equivalent of Woman Lists on desktop.

- Refresh the list.
- Change sort order.

Menu



- Tap on the patient's name, or the red and white arrow to access this menu.
- The list of tabs is the same as on desktop.
- Full Notes shows all notes.
- Scroll down the tab list and you can switch user like on desktop.

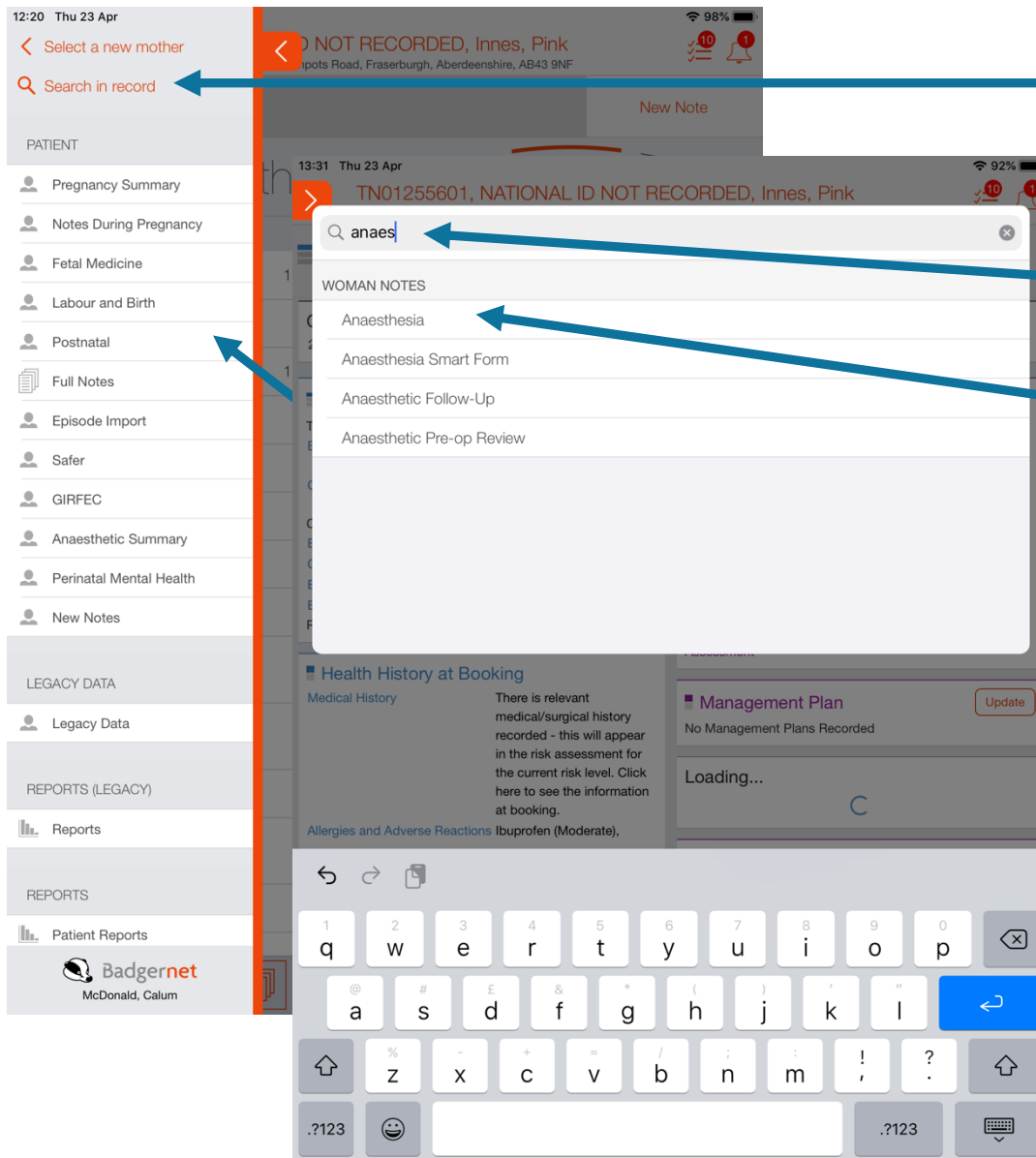

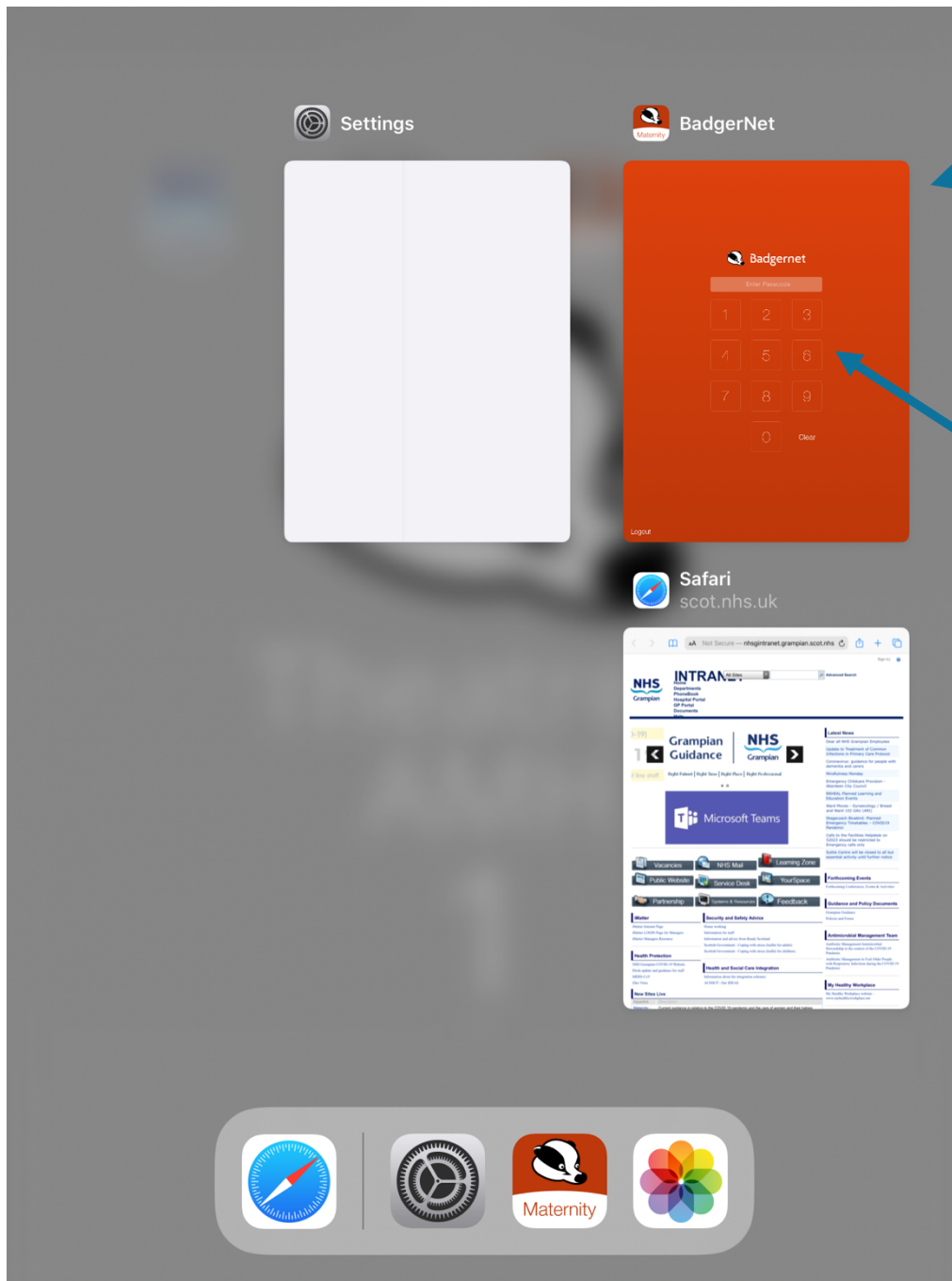

- All the notes are the same as on BadgerNet on the PC, they are just presented in a different way.
- Change the date and time of the note by tapping here.
- This window will pop-up. Scroll to change the date and time.
- Tap on the fields to enter information.

iPad Offline



- Occasionally, if the iPad may lose the WiFi connection and then reconnect.
- This can cause the BadgerNet app to go in to offline mode even though the WiFi is connected.
- To reconnect:
 - Double click the home button at the bottom of the iPad.
 - Swipe the BadgerNet app up to close it.
 - Press the home button to go back to the main screen.
 - Re-open BadgerNet.
