Checklists

- 1. The following resus airway related checklists / aide-mémoire should be bound in the corner with a metal ring and hanging on a hook at the head end of the resus cubicle (indicated by orange sign):
 - RSI Checklist
 - Salbutamol Delivery to Intubated Patients
 - Transfer of the Neurocritical Patient
 - Procedural Sedation Checklist
 - Cardioversion Checklist

Top of the Trolley

Remove everything from the top of the airway trolley, including infusion pumps, to ensure it is clear, ready to lay out equipment for the primary airway management plan.

- 10. Roll of tape (zinc oxide) × 1
