HOSPITAL AT HOME

Edinburgh Hospital at Home are trialling accepting 2 referrals daily from ED overnight. This will allow patients to have their initial management in ED and then be followed up by H@H in their own home

ED

IDENTIFY PATIENT:

Edinburgh city council resident Use criteria in H@H poster Patient and/or NOK consent

CHECK AVAILABILITY:

Two slots daily in H@H clinic – please check and book your patient into this clinic if space allows

BEFORE DISCHARGE:

- 1. Give H@H leaflet with our contact number to patient and/or NOK
 - 2. Ensure a contact number for patient and/or NOK documented in your clinical note
- Document all drugs given/changed in clinical note and give prescription chart of any IV antibiotics administered to patient to be kept at home

HOSPITAL AT HOME

Edinburgh Hospital at Home are trialling accepting 2 referrals daily from ED overnight. This will allow patients to have their initial management in ED and then be followed up by H@H in their own home



IDENTIFY PATIENT:

Nurse coordinator will check H@H clinic daily between 8 – 9am They will review the case, if appropriate they will:

- 1. Admit to H@H ward and arrange review
- 2. Contact patient and/or NOK to confirm details of home assessment
- 3. Generate letter to GP informing of them of admission under H@H

Any patient felt not to be appropriate should be discussed with consultant of the day as soon as possible. They will arrange alternative follow up if required and complete a letter to GP
