- 0.4 Turn left onto Old Dalkeith Rd/A7
- 0.6 Turn right onto Ferniehill Rd/B701
- 1.3 Turn left onto Drum St/A772
- 1.7 At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Gilmerton Station Rd
- 2.4 At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Lasswade Rd
- 2.5 Turn right to merge onto A720 (City Bypass) towards A90/M8/M9/Glasgow/Stirling/Edinburgh
- 10.2 Take the M8 exit towards Glasgow/Forth Road Bridge/A90/Stirling/Livingston/M9
- 10.4 At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto M8 heading to Glasgow
- 19.0 At junction 3, exit onto Livingston Rd/A899 towards Livingston
- 20.5 Merge onto Cousland Rd/A705 via the slip road to Heritage Centre/Blackburn/Whitburn/Howden/Eliburn/Kirkton/Ladywell
- 20.9 Take the exit towards Howden/Ladywell/Kirkton/Eliburn South/Eliburn East
- 21.0 At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Howden E Rd
- 21.3 Turn left
- 21.4 Turn right. Destination will be on the left
